

## About the Woonsocket Homeless Shelter

Thirty years ago, Paul Dempster, Bruce Daigle, and Rabbi Joel Chernoff had a vision for helping the homeless and opened the Woonsocket Shelter. ShelterWalk has been a foundation for keeping their vision alive.

Over the years the Shelter made a difference in the lives of countless people who found themselves struggling at the poverty line by providing a place to live along with the resources and tools people needed to obtain a permanent home.

Today, the Woonsocket Shelter is still providing more than a bed with life-skills tools, such as Money Sense and job training classes; and connecting with services, such as counseling, child development, and after school programs.

At any given time, 20 families and 8 single women live at the shelter; and every day we see their hopes come alive. Last year, out of 61 families, 90% achieved their ultimate goal and moved into permanent housing.

Funds raised will support the Community Care Alliance Woonsocket Shelter and Homelessness Prevention Programs.
