The 'just for you' giving center was created out of an expressed need by a Rotarian and foster parent for thirty years, who saw a need for alternative resources to provide for foster children coming to his home through emergency placements.

Foster families not only open their homes and hearts to the children who are being removed from the only home they know, but also their wallets. They have experienced a school-age child's anxiety over returning to school in the same outfit day after day or in pajamas because that's all they brought with them. Many times, a baby in emergency placement comes with no appropriate clothing, blankets or diapers. Significantly, funding vouchers have been reduced dramatically over the past several years, resulting in more need for these resources.

But this is not just for foster families. There are many other families that do not have the clothing and basic needs required to raise a child.

That is why the Rotary Club of Woonsocket decided to do something to help foster, homeless, and disadvantaged children and opened 'just for you,' a closet filled with new and gently used clothes and items at no cost. The 'just for you' giving center was created for children referred by Community Care Alliance, DCYF, and the Woonsocket Rotary Club,

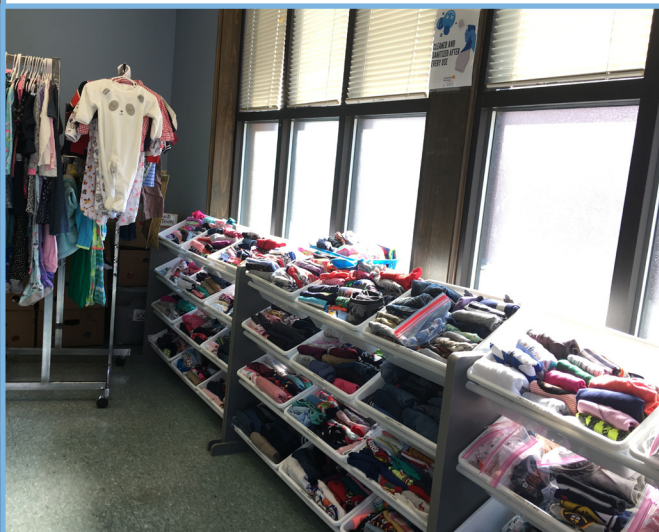
Items are donated and available at no cost...
