

Dear Milk Fund Applicant,

The Board of Directors of Milk Fund, Inc. has established the following criteria for Milk Fund eligibility for 2026. In order to be eligible for milk fund your family must meet one of the categories below as well as meet income guidelines also listed below.

The categories are listed in order of priority:

1. Children of working low income families.
2. Children of low income families where the wage earner is unemployed or family member is deployed in the military.
3. Elderly (age 60 and older), with health or nutritional needs.

If you are eligible based on criteria's above, please complete **all information on both sides** of the application form and return it, **with proof of income**, and copies of Birth Certificates of your children. Incomplete applications will not be processed and will be sent back to you.

Examples of proof of income may include one of the following:

Copies of the last few pay stubs

Copy of a benefit check for Unemployment, Social Security, SSI, and SSDI.

Copy of bank statement if you have direct deposit

Include a **non-returnable** copy of your proof of income, or you may stop in at Community Care Alliance at 68 Cumberland Street, Suite 200, Woonsocket, with your application. We are open Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30p.m. **Please bring proof of income and birth certificates of your children with you. We will make a copy of it at that time.**

If your application is approved and you are accepted into the 2026 Milk Fund program, your vouchers will be mailed directly to you. This will continue on through the remainder of the year unless your eligibility changes, fraudulent use of the vouchers is discovered, or funding is no longer available to provide the vouchers.
